Tuition and Fee Schedule

2011-2012 School Year

August 24, 2011 – May 25, 2012

Rosehill Montessori School is a parent-run not-for-profit school dedicated to providing quality preschool and kindergarten educational experiences for children ages three to six years old. We are open Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and offer a variety of full-day, extended-day, and half-day programs.

The following table summarizes Rosehill’s programs for the 2011-2012 academic school year, which runs from August 24, 2011 to May 25, 2012. Tuition is payable in 9 equal monthly installments (September – May), each for the amount indicated in the table.

Discounts

Sibling Discount

Families who enroll more than one child during the academic school year will receive a 15% discount on the lesser tuition.

Full Year Pre-payment Discount

Families who choose to pay the full academic school year’s tuition by September 1, 2012, will receive a 5% discount on the entire amount.

Rates and Fees

Enrollment

The annual enrollment fee is \$200 for the first student, and \$100 for each additional student. For new family enrollments 50% of the first month's installment is due with the enrollment application. These payments are non-refundable and are due at the time of enrollment.

Volunteer Deposit

Rosehill Montessori School is a parent run, not-for-profit school. We depend on parent volunteers to help with many activities. Once your child is accepted for admission, we require a \$300.00 (per family) refundable volunteer deposit. We require 20 hours of volunteer time per school year per family. At the beginning of the following school year, families who have completed their 20-hour obligation will receive credit for their volunteer deposit. For continuing families, this credit will be applied to the next year's deposit. For families whose child(ren) graduated, a refund will be issued. Although we ask for at least 20 hours of volunteer time, the majority of our families go above and beyond the minimum hours required, which is one key to making our school unique and effective.

Hourly Rate

The non-contracted hourly rate is \$10.00 per hour. If your child is at school prior to or past his/her scheduled hours, your account will be billed at this rate in 15-minute increments.

After Hours Fee

If your child is at school past the scheduled closing time (typically 6:00 p.m.), your account will be billed at the rate of \$15.00 for *each 15 minutes* or fraction thereof.

Late Tuition Fee

Monthly installment payments are due on the 1st of the month. Any account for which payment is not received by the 6th of the month is subject to a \$15.00 late fee and an additional \$1.00 per day thereafter until payment in full (including late fees) is received. If a payment is 30 days past due, your child will automatically be disenrolled.

Holiday Program

To serve families with working parents, Rosehill offers a child care "Holiday Program" on most weekdays on which regular classes are not in session. These days are marked on the calendar as "Open for Holiday Program Only." Montessori work, games, arts, crafts, outside play, and other activities will be provided on Holiday Program Days. All children enrolled in a standard full time program (to 6:00 p.m., 5 days per week) receive the Holiday Program days at no additional charge. Children enrolled in other programs may attend the Holiday Program for an additional daily fee of between \$30.00 and \$70.00, depending on the hours.

Admissions Policy

Rosehill Montessori School admits all students regardless of color, creed, national or ethnic origin, to all the rights and privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate in the administration of its educational policies or other school-administered programs. Spaces are filled according to availability of programs, with priority registration given to currently enrolled students and their siblings, and then on a first-come, first-served basis. Children ages three through six can be enrolled at any time of the year.
