### STUDENT ACTIVITIES — at Home

#### Chocolate "Dirt" Cups

Rainy days don't have to be gloomy. Just because your kids can't go outside doesn't mean they can't dig into the dirt and spoon up a delicious snack. Makes 8 to 10 individual cups.

#### Ingredients:

- 1 package (16 oz.) chocolate sandwich cookies, crushed
- 2 cups cold milk
- 1 package (4-serving size) JELL-O® Chocolate Flavor Instant Pudding and Pie Filling
- 1 tub (8 oz.) COOL WHIP® Whipped Topping, thawed
- Decorations: gummy worms, candy flowers, chopped peanuts, granola

#### Kitchen Tools:

- A measuring cup
- 8 to 10 (7 oz.) Dixie® Kitchen cups
- a large bowl
- a rolling pin
- a wire whisk
- a zipper style plastic bag

#### Directions:

1. Put the cookies into a zipper style plastic bag. Close the bag tightly. Use a rolling pin to crush the cookies until they are as fine as "dirt".
2. Pour milk into a large bowl.  
Add pudding mix.  
Beat with a wire whisk, 1 to 2 minutes, until well blended.  
Let stand 5 minutes.  
Stir in whipped toppings and 1/2 of the crushed cookies.
3. Place one tablespoon crushed cookies into cups.  
Fill cups about 3/4 full with pudding mixture.  
Top with remaining cookies.
4. Refrigerate one hour.
5. Plant gummy worms or other candy creatures into the cups of "dirt".
